STORYTIME Join Ms. Linda every Friday morning in the children's room at 10:30 for a story, some singing and an all-around fun time.



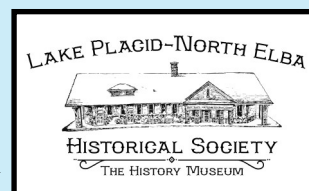
